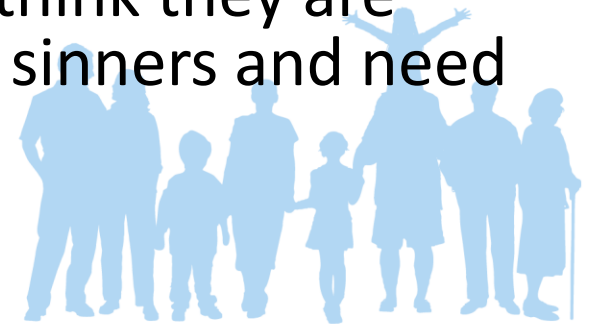

²⁷ Later, as Jesus left the town, he saw a tax collector named Levi sitting at his tax collector's booth.
