What is Worship?

Worship is to honor with extravagant love and extreme submission (*Webster's Dictionary, 1828*)

Lips and Deeds

or

Mouth, Hands and Feet

Hebrews 13:15-16 Therefore, let us offer through Jesus a continual sacrifice of praise to God, proclaiming our allegiance to his name. 16 And don't forget to do good and to share with those in need. These are the sacrifices that please God.

What is Worship?

It is our response to who God is

Valuing and treasuring God above all things (*revering, delighting in God, prizing God, being satisfied in God above all things, exalting above all things*)

Greek: proskuneó

Definition: I go down on my knees to, do obeisance to, worship and adore

What is worship?

It is truth that comes from our heart

John 4:24 God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in the Spirit and in truth.”

Psalms 51:16-17 “You do not desire a sacrifice, or I would offer one. You do not want a burnt offering. The sacrifice you desire is a broken spirit. You will not reject a broken and repentant heart, O God.”

Mark 7:6-7 He replied, “Isaiah was right when he prophesied about you hypocrites; as it is written:

‘These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me.’ 7 They worship me in vain...


What is Worship?

It is a response

Matthew 14:33 Then those who were in the boat worshiped him, saying, “Truly you are the Son of God.”

Matthew 28:8-9 So the women hurried away from the tomb, afraid yet filled with joy, and ran to tell his disciples. Suddenly Jesus met them. “Greetings,” he said. They came to him, clasped his feet and worshiped him.

Psalms 28:6-8 Praise the Lord! For he has heard my cry for mercy. 7 The Lord is my strength and shield I trust him with all my heart He helps me, and my heart is filled with joy. I burst out in songs of thanksgiving. 8 The Lord gives his people strength. He is a safe fortress for his anointed king.




What is Worship?





What is Worship?


It is primary

Worship is referred to over 8600 times in scripture

Exodus 20:3 “You shall have no other gods before me.

Luke 4:8 Jesus answered, “It is written: ‘Worship the Lord your God and serve him only.’”

Romans 12:1 Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God’s mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship.



What is Worship?

It is what we do no matter the circumstances

Acts 16:25 About midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the other prisoners were listening to them.

Job 1:20-21 ...Job got up and tore his robe and shaved his head. Then he fell to the ground in worship 21 and said: “Naked I came from my mother’s womb, and naked I will depart. The Lord gave and the Lord has taken away; may the name of the Lord be praised.”
