Good Judgement vs Bad Judgement





Romans 14:10, 12, 13, "You, then, why do you judge your brother or sister? Or why do you treat them with contempt? For we will all stand before God's judgment seat... So then, each of us will give an account of ourselves to God. Therefore let us stop passing judgment on one another.

Contempt: the feeling that a person or a thing is beneath consideration, worthless, or deserving scorn.
