The Choice of our heart to “Lift Our Eyes Up”

James 4:1-7 What causes fights and quarrels among you? Don't they come from your desires that battle within you? ...Therefore, anyone who chooses to be a friend of the world becomes an enemy of God.⁵ Or do you think Scripture says without reason that he jealously longs for the spirit he has caused to dwell in us? ⁶ But he gives us more grace. That is why Scripture says: “God opposes the proud but shows favor to the humble.”⁷ Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
