Insecurities

- Meeting people we don't know
- Public speaking / performance
- Swimsuit in public
- Getting dressed up
- Public temper tantrums
- Job interview
- Confrontations / difficult conversations
- Asked to do something beyond your experience or skill set

• Are you aware of your insecurities? The fear(s) behind them?

#### How we try to cope

- Avoid / withdraw
  - limit experiences, shut down, procrastinate, distract, drug of choice
- Overcompensate/prove our worth
  - control, seek perfection, self-promotion, pretend to be different

Neither path satisfies – neither path answers the question.

#### What do we really want to know?

True security is knowing and resting in the reality that you are deeply loved for who you are, not what you do.

The world can't answer that question – but we keep trying to find it there. "Listen to your shepherd, not the other sheep."
